



Hence, the university may utilize the facilities/ journal made available by the INFLIBNET/ National Digital Library.2. UGC vide its letter No.F.1-1/2012 (CU) dated 17.09.2016, 25.11.2016 and 2.3.2017 circulated the guidelines for approval of building projects. University may strictly follow the procedure of approval of building projects as per above stated UGC guidelines and send the proposal for construction/renovation/ repairs costing more than Rs.75.00 lakhs to UGC for seeking prior approval of UGC Standing Committee.3. University may not initiate the work / project i.e. approach road, water pipe line, electric sub-station etc. which are the responsibility of the State Government. In this regard, university may take up the matter with State Government/Central Government/UGC as the case may be.4. University should follow the General Financial Rules, 2017 as well as instructions of GFR 130 to 141 pertaining to execution of the works.		
		

7. University may fill up the teaching posts as per UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualification for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 and as amended from time to time and make serious efforts to fill up the teaching posts at the earliest.
8. University may strictly follow the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree), Regulations, 2016 and as amended from time to time.
9. University may follow the reservation policy of Govt. of India / UGC for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD in appointment of teaching and non-teaching staff and for reservation in admissions.
10. University may fill up the backlog vacancies for SC/ST/OBC/PwD at the earliest to fulfill the statutory requirement of Govt. of India.
11. University may obtain prior approval of UGC for running the courses through Distance Education otherwise running of these courses would be treated as unapproved.
12. University may not book the expenditure under salary head for those posts which were sanctioned under specific scheme i.e. Centre for Women Studies, Academic Staff College, Centre for Social Exclusion and Inclusion Policy etc. unless and until university has obtained the prior approval of UGC for merger of these posts into regular salary head. The salary expenditure of these schemes may be booked under the specific scheme only.
13. University should not create any new posts/pay scales or upgrade at its level without prior approval of UGC/Govt. of India as already communicated to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.31-3/97(CU) dated 10th April, 1998.
14. University may maintain a Register of sanctioned posts (teaching and non-teaching) as communicated vide UGC letter No.F.19-15/2001(CU) dated 11th December, 2001.
15. University must ensure timely submission of the Audited Annual Accounts and Annual Reports to Ministry and also ensure the observance of the time schedule for preparation of Annual accounts and their submission to audit authorities.
16. The MHRD (now MoE) has clearly articulated the guidelines for financial management in central universities and procedure has been well laid down in the MHRD (now MoE) letter No.F.61-19/2005-Desk (U) dated 3rd March, 2016. Therefore, university may ensure that the instructions to maintain financial propriety are strictly followed and no deviation from the procedure be allowed.
17. UGC vide its letter No.13-2/2017 (CU) dated 27th May, 2017 has sent a letter to all central universities for adoption of General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017. Therefore, university may strictly follow the General Financial Rules, 2017.
18. The University may take immediate action for its accreditation/re-accreditation by National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC).
19. Universities be advised not to start the courses under School of Education / Faculty of Education / Department of Education (B.Ed, M.Ed, etc) without prior approval of the NCTE. University may start only those courses under School of Education / Faculty of Education / Department of Education which are approved by UGC and not change the nomenclature of these courses on its own.
20. All interests earned against Grants-in-Aid (other than reimbursement) released to university should be mandatorily remitted to UGC account immediately after finalization of accounts. Any Interest earned out of Grants in aid should not be treated as additional funds over and above the allocation.
21. University must ensure that the Institution has implemented the EAT Module. UGC has already instructed the instructions in this regard to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.17-1/2015 (FD-II) dated 26th June, 2018 and subsequently vide UGC letter No.F.9-4/2018 (CU) dated 13th July, 2018. Further, University shall send the EAT report (downloaded from PFMS portal) of their expenditure of grants received from UGC different scheme along with Utilization Certificate duly signed by the Head of the Institution.
22. **Grantee Institutions of the UGC shall ensure that all payments of approved items to the beneficiary vendors shall be made only through the TSA module of PFMS and assignments received from the UGC through TSA module have to be utilized before 31st March of the year. Balance remaining unutilized at the close of the year (31st March) will lapse to the Government and hence return back in Government Account.**
23. MoE vide its letter No. F.20-1/2019-CU.Cdn dated 16th June, 2020 communicated the all Central Universities that now the powers to create teaching and non-teaching posts have not been delegated to either MoE or the UGC as on date. Therefore, University may send the proposal for creation of any teaching or non-teaching posts for seeking approval of Ministry of Finance through Ministry of Education.
24. It has been observed that some of the central universities have hired more persons through outsourcing these positions approved by UGC. All the Central Universities are informed that the number of persons appointed against sanctioned number of outsourced positions should not be in excess against the number of positions approved by UGC. The expenditure on manpower through outsourcing in excess of positions sanctioned by UGC will be treated as unapproved expenditure, if there is any genuine requirement to appoint more persons on outsource basis, University may approach the UGC for prior sanction of more positions, giving full justification.

19. Universities be advised not to start the courses under School of Education / Faculty of Education / Department of Education (B.Ed, M.Ed. etc) without prior approval of the NCTE. University may start only those courses under School of Education / Faculty of Education / Department of Education which are approved by UGC and not change the nomenclature of these courses on its own.
20. All interests earned against Grants-in-Aid (other than reimbursement) released to university should be mandatorily remitted to UGC account immediately after finalization of accounts. Any interest earned out of Grants in aid should not be treated as additional funds over and above the allocation.
21. University must ensure that the Institution has implemented the EAT Module. UGC has already instructed the instructions in this regard to all Central Universities vide UGC letter No.F.17-1/2015 (FD-II) dated 26th June, 2018 and subsequently vide UGC letter No.F.9-4/2018 (CU) dated 13th July, 2018. Further, University shall send the EAT report (downloaded from PFMS portal) of their expenditure of grants received from UGC different scheme along with Utilization Certificate duly signed by the Head of the Institution.
22. **Grantee Institutions of the UGC shall ensure that all payments of approved items to the beneficiary vendors shall be made only through the TSA module of PFMS and assignments received from the UGC through TSA module have to be utilized before 31st March of the year. Balance remaining unutilized at the close of the year (31st March) will lapse to the Government and hence return back in Government Account.**
23. MoE vide its letter No. F.20-1/2019-CU.Cdn dated 16th June, 2020 communicated the all Central Universities that now the powers to create teaching and non-teaching posts have not been delegated to either MoE or the UGC as on date. Therefore, University may send the proposal for creation of any teaching or non-teaching posts for seeking approval of Ministry of Finance through Ministry of Education.
24. It has been observed that some of the central universities have hired more persons through outsourcing those positions approved by UGC. All the Central Universities are informed that the number of persons appointed against sanctioned number of outsourced positions should not be in excess against the number of positions approved by UGC. The expenditure on manpower through outsourcing in excess of positions sanctioned by UGC will be treated as unapproved expenditure, if there is any genuine requirement to appoint more persons on outsource basis, University may approach the UGC for prior sanction of more positions, giving full justification.

Sir/Madam,

This is to inform you that on the basis of the Revised Budget Estimates 2022-23 (R.B.E. 2022-23) documents submitted by the University and availability of funds from Govt. of India, the R.B.E. for the year 2022-23 under Salary Head has been fixed at Rs.4726.00 lakhs for Central University of Rajasthan after adjusting the unspent balances available with the University as on 01.04.2022 on the basis of the allocation made by the Ministry of Education, GoI. The details of the Revised Budget Estimates for the year 2022-23 are as under:-

The above allocation of salary grant for the year 2022-2023 is subject to the following conditions:-

- (A) Grant under OH-36 should be utilised only for payment of salary of regular employees against sanctioned post and retirement benefits of employees and arrears;
- (B) Salary and wages of contractual faculty and non-faculty staff are to be paid from the grant under OH:31 and in no case the grant meant for salary of regular employees under OH:36 is utilized for this purpose.


The university may also take an appropriate action on the following observations:-

- The Internal Receipts (IR) like sale of prospectus, income on conduct of entrance examinations etc. are part of the Internal Receipts. Therefore, all these internal receipts should be taken into account under overall internal receipts and may not be transferred to any other head.
- UGC has been allowing the Central Universities to use the Internal Receipts to cover up the shortfall under Non-salary expenditure (Recurring Head) with the approval of the Commission. However, the Central Universities are advised to make serious efforts to implement the austerity measures to reduce the Recurring expenditure in view of the instructions issued by the GoI/UGC from time to time.
- (a) Payment of pension and pensionary benefits; (b) Salary and TA/DA etc. paid to consultants appointed under a scheme and (c) Salary / wages paid to contractual staff appointed under a scheme etc. shall be met out of funds provided under object head 31 – Grants in aid – General.
- The vacancies available against sanctioned non-teaching positions can be filled up by the university under intimation to UGC, if the teaching to non-teaching ratio is less than 1:1.1 as prescribed by Govt. of India.
- It is advised that university may reduce the staff engaged on contract basis or through outsource agency in order to reduce the expenditure under Recurring head. The university may make the optimum utilization of their resources on engagement of contractual employees.

5. The Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) vide its letter No.011/VGL/014 dated 11th February, 2011 has circulated the instructions on "Transparency in Tendering System" and No.01-11-CTE-SH-100 dated 17.02.2011 regarding "Mobilization - Advance". Therefore, the construction work should strictly be as per General Financial Rules, 2017 and CVC instructions issued from time to time.
6. The MHRD (now MoE) has clearly articulated the guidelines for financial management in Central Universities and procedure has been well laid down in the MHRD letter No.F.61-19/2005-Desk (U) dated 3rd March, 2016. Therefore, university may ensure that the instructions to maintain financial propriety are strictly followed and no deviation from the procedure be allowed.
7. UGC vide its letter No.F.13-2/2017 (CU) dated 27th May, 2017 has sent a letter to all central universities for adoption of General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017. Therefore, university should follow the General Financial Rules, 2017.
8. University may follow the reservation policy of Govt. of India/UGC for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD in appointment of teaching and non-teaching staff and for reservation in admissions the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act 2006 and as amended in 2012 may be followed.
9. University may fill up the backlog vacancies for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD at the earliest to fulfil the statutory requirement of Govt. of India.
10. All statutory posts should be filled by appointment through Selection Committee as per UGC Regulations.
11. University may fill up the teaching posts as per UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualification for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 as amended from time to time and make serious efforts to fill up the teaching posts at the earliest.

I would also like to request you to ensure that the utilization of the grants received by the university shall be submitted to the UGC in time to enable smooth management of funds, to avoid unnecessary audit objections and Pull back by RBI (TSA). The release of grant would depend on the pace of expenditure by the University & timely submission of utilization certificate / statement of expenditure.

The Court: The University Court is the authority of the University has the power to review, from time to time, the broad policies and programmes of the University, and to suggest measures for the improvement and development of the University. For more details, please visit Section 20 and Statute 10, CUs Act, 2009. The term of first Court has been expired on 06-10-2016. The constitution of the second Court is under process.

Executive Council: The Executive Council is the principal executive body of the University. The Executive Council shall have the power of management and administration of the revenues and property of the University and the conduct of all administrative affairs of the University not otherwise provided for. For more details, please visit Statute 12, CUs Act, 2009.

Academic Council: The Academic Council is the principal academic body of University and shall, subject to the provision of this Act, the Statutes and the Ordinances, Coordinate and exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the University. For more details, please visit Statute 14, CUs Act, 2009.

Finance Committee: Finance Committee is the authority of the University to examine the account and to scrutinize the proposal for expenditure. For more details, please visit Statute 17, CUs Act, 2009.

The RTI Cell accepts various fees prescribed under the Act, both in Cash against a proper receipt, as well as through IPO/DD/Banker's cheque drawn in the name of the University. The RTI Cell also facilitates the applicants by providing them information on the status of their Applications and any other information required by them in connection with RTI Applications filed by them in University.

The person seeking information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 may apply on a plain paper giving particulars of information being sought and his/her correct address for communication.

A request for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of section 6 of RTI Act, 2005 shall be accompanied by an application fee of rupees ten (Rs. 10/-) by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order payable to the Central University of Rajasthan.

For providing the information to the applicant under sub-section (1) of section 7 of RTI Act, 2005, the fee shall be charged by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order payable to the Central University of Rajasthan at the following rates:-

- rupees two for each page (in A4 or A3 size paper) created or copied;
- actual charges or cost price of a copy in larger size paper;
- actual cost or price for samples or models; and
- for inspection of records, no fee for the first hour; and a fee of rupees five for each subsequent hour (or fraction thereof.)

For providing the information to the applicant under sub-section (5) of section 7 of RTI Act, 2005, the fee shall be charged by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order payable to the Registrar, Central University of Rajasthan at the following rates:-

- for information provided in diskette or floppy rupees fifty per diskette or floppy; and
- for information provided in printed form at the price fixed for such publication or rupees two per page of photocopy for extracts from the publications.

Online Web Portal to file RTI Applications:

A Web Portal namely RTI Online with url <https://rtionline.gov.in/> has been launched. This portal, developed by NIC, is a facility for the Indian Citizens to online file RTI applications and first appeals and also to make online payment of RTI fees.

It is an initiative taken by Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions to provide a – RTI Portal Gateway to the citizens for quick search of information on the details of first Appellate Authorities, PIOs etc. amongst others, besides access to RTI related information / disclosures published on the web by various Public Authorities under the government of India as well as the State Governments.

The prescribed fees can be paid through Internet banking of State Bank of India and its associate banks as well as by Credit/Debit cards of Visa/Master, RuPay cards through the payment gateway of SBI linked to this site.

The instructions on the home page of the Online Portal clearly indicate viz. 'Please do not file RTI applications through this portal for the public authorities under the State Governments, including Government of NCT Delhi. If filed, the application would be returned, without refund of amount.'

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

GRIEVANCES REDRESSAL MECHANISM

1. Public Grievances Portal (PG Portal):

- i) The Govt. of India has launched a portal named 'Public Grievances Portal (pgportal.gov.in/cpgoffice/), wherein complainants may lodge their grievances on-line. The Public Grievance Redress Mechanism in Government of India functions on a decentralized basis.
- ii) Pgportal is an online system for facilitating citizen for lodging of grievances from anywhere, anytime 24x7. The system enables Ministries/Departments close monitoring of the grievances received for expeditious disposal and upload Action Taken Report. The citizens can view the status of action taken. There is also a feedback mechanism for satisfaction rating by the complainant of the action taken which may lead to further improvements.
- iii) On successful lodging of a grievance an acknowledgment is auto generated on the online system. A grievance received by post is acknowledged within three days of the receipt. A grievance received by hand is acknowledged at the same time.
- iv) The public grievances received on-line will be forwarded through PG portal and hard copies of grievances received on-line will not be forwarded.
- v) Efforts shall be made to redress the grievance within a period of 60 days. If disposal of grievance petition is anticipated to take longer than 60 days, an interim reply would invariably be sent.
- vi) The following types of grievances are not taken up for redress by the University –
 - (a) Subjudice cases or any matter concerning judgment given by any court,
 - (b) Personal and family disputes and
 - (c) RTI matters.
- vii) The Registrar, Central University of Rajasthan has been designated as Nodal Officer / Director of Grievances in the University.

2. Employees and Students' Grievances Redressal Committee (as per the Ordinance 28 under Section 28(n) of the Act, 2009):

There is a mechanism in the University for the redressal of the grievances of Employees and Students of the University.

The Grievances Committee shall observe the following general principles:

1. The Campus Community should be made fully aware of the grievance redressal mechanism;
2. Every grievance from the student/staff should be registered and acknowledged;

3. If a final decision is not possible within a fortnight, an acknowledgement should be sent to the applicant along with an indication as to when he/she can expect a final reply;
4. As a matter of general rule no grievances should be pending beyond the limit of three months;
5. The officer nominated by the Vice Chancellor and the person responsible for addressing grievances should make himself/herself freely available to hear the grievances personally, at least once a week at fixed timings; and
6. He/she will take decisions on grievances which are pending for more than three months. Aggrieved parties who are not satisfied with redressal in subordinate/attached formation can approach the Vice Chancellor for a decision.

I. Students Grievance Redressal Committee:

Chairman – The Pro Vice-Chancellor or such other person to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

Members:

- 3 Representatives of Students' Council.
- 3 Nominees of the Vice Chancellor.
- Dean of Students' welfare, Member-Secretary.
- Dean of the School concerned (special invitee)

Powers and Functions:

- i. to entertain written and signed complaints and petitions of students in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as a group;
- ii. to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or suitable action; and
- iii. to recommend appropriate action against complainant, if allegations made in the documents are found to be baseless.

II. TEACHERS' GRIEVANCES COMMITTEE

The constitution of the Committee by the Executive Council consisting of the following:

- A representative of the Vice Chancellor, Chairman
- Five representatives from the teachers community representing gender, minority, SC, ST, OBC.
- Vice Chancellor's nominee shall be the Secretary to the Committee.

Powers and Functions:

- (I) to entertain written and signed complaints and petitions of teachers in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as group;
- (II) to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities-Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or suitable action; and
- (III) to recommend appropriate action against complainant, if allegations made in the documents found to be baseless.

III. NON-TEACHING STAFF GRIEVANCES COMMITTEE

- The Chairman - to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor.
- Five representatives from the non-teaching community representing gender, minority, SC, ST, OBC.
- The Registrar or his nominee shall be the Member- Secretary of the Committee.

Powers and Functions:

- (i) to accept and consider written and signed complaints and petitions of staff (Non-Teaching) in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as a group;
- (ii) to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities-Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or suitable action; and to recommend appropriate action against complaints, if allegations made in the documents found to be baseless.

3. Details of Application received under RTI and information provided

The Central University of Rajasthan proactively discloses the RTI applications and appeals received and their responses on its websites i.e. www.curaj.ac.in with the search facility based on key words keeping in view of the provisions under Section 8 and 9 of RTI Act, 2005. Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Accounts of Central University of Rajasthan, Bandarsindri, Kishangarh (Ajmer) for the year ended 31 March 2022

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of the Central University of Rajasthan (CURAJ), Bandarsindri, Kishangarh (Ajmer) as at 31 March 2022, the Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 31(1) of the Central University Act, 2009. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Central University of Rajasthan's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (C&AG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards, disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/C&AG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with the auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that:

i. We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit.

ii. The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India vide order No. 29-4/ 2012-FD dated 17 April 2015.

iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the Central University of Rajasthan, Bandarsindri, Kishangarh (Ajmer) as required in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.

A. Application of Funds

Balance Sheet of the University

A.1 Fixed Assets-Capital WIP-HEFA Loan Scheme (Schedule-4B): ₹ 16.40 crore

This includes unutilised balance of advances issued to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) for capital works amounting to ₹ 2.89 crore as on 31.03.2022. The amount was to be shown under Schedule-8: Loans, Advances & Deposits.

This has resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 2.89 crore and understatement of Loans, Advances & Deposits by the same amount.

B. General

B.1 CURAJ had incurred expenditure on construction of various works/buildings. The same had been completed by the CPWD. However, CURAJ has neither capitalised these assets nor charged depreciation thereon.

This comment has also been raised in the SARs since 2016-17, but the irregularity persists.

C. Grant-in-aid

The CURAJ has received grant-in-aid of ₹ 51.67 crore (including refund of ₹ 2.60 crore by Public Health Engineering Department) during the year 2021-22. Unspent grant of ₹ 13.10 crore was available at the beginning of the year. Out of total available grant of ₹ 60.01 crore (excluding refund/pull back of ₹ 4.76 crore by University Grants Commission), CURAJ could utilise ₹ 49.50 crore (Capital expenditure: ₹ 3.64 crore and Revenue expenditure: ₹ 45.86 crore) leaving a balance of ₹ 10.51 crore at the end of the year.

D. Management Letter

Deficiencies, which have not been included in the SAR, have been brought to the notice of the Management through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

v. Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

vi. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statement, read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts and subject to the significant matters, stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India.





Out of this, ₹ 16.40 crore had been released to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) upto 31.3.2022. General</p> <p>B.1 As per the instructions issued for Schedule-4 in Formats of Financial Statements for Central Higher Educational Institutions issued by MHRD "Fixed Assets in the course of construction should be shown against this head till they are ready for their intended use." Buildings/premises shall be those which are intended to be wholly/partly used for the purposes of the activities of the Entity and would not include "Investment Properties". Further, para 3.6 of Schedule-23: Significant Accounting Policies provides that depreciation on Buildings is provided on Written Down Value (WDV) method at the rate of 5 per cent.</p> <p>It was noticed that CURAJ had incurred expenditure on construction of various works/buildings. The same had been completed by the CPWD. However, CURAJ had neither capitalised nor depreciation was charged thereon.</p> <p>This comment was also raised in Separate Audit Reports for the years 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 but the irregularity persists.</p>	<p>The Capitalization of buildings and works in under active consideration of the University. University could not be able to capitalize the various works due to non-availability of proper documents required for capitalization such as, certified copy of final bill against cash work, comprehensive list of inventory etc. In this connection, University has already written multiple letters to CPWD authority. Thus, E-Books were mis-classified as Library Books and Scientific Journals under Fixed Assets.</p> <p>On being pointed out vide audit enquiry no. 115710 dated 08.07.2022, it was replied that due to oversight, that amount was included in Library Books & Scientific Journals, while presenting in annual accounts. Proper head of accounts will be corrected during the FY 2022-23 to reflect proper classification of Fixed Assets.</p>	<p>E-Books of amounting to Rs. 40,93,538/- has been purchased during the F.Y. 2021-22. Due to oversight that amount included in Library Books & Scientific Journals (Tangible Assets) instead of E-Books & Journals (Intangible Assets), while presenting the same in Annual accounts.</p> <p>Proper head of accounts corrected during the F.Y. 2022-23 to reflect proper classification of Fixed Assets, (copy of voucher attached) since there is no effect on gross assets/fixed assets schedule, audit is requested to drop the Para.</p>

B.3 Significant Accounting Policies (Schedule 23, Para 3.7-1) of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 provides that the depreciation is charged for the full year if the assets are acquired upto 30 September, otherwise 50 per cent of the prescribed rate is applicable. It also provides (Para 3.7-ii) that depreciation on the individual assets costing less than or equal to ₹ 5000 (except Library Books) is charged at the rate of 100 per cent.

It was noticed that depreciation on three assets has been overcharged by ₹ 2.05 lakh and that on one asset has been undercharged by ₹ 1.75 lakh. Thus, depreciation has been overcharged by ₹ 0.30 lakh. Details are as under:

This has resulted in understatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 0.30 lakh and understatement of Corpus/Capital fund by the same amount.

On being pointed out vide audit enquiry no. 115667 dated 08.07.2022, it was replied that the depreciation has been charged as per approved rates of the University and Accounting Policy. Due to calculation errors, depreciation was charged for the whole year instead of half year which has now been corrected and the same has been reflected to the books of Accounts during the FY 2022-23.

C. Net impact of audit comments on Accounts


The net impact of comments given in the preceding paragraphs is that as on 31 March 2022 assets were understated by ₹ 0.30 lakh and liabilities were understated by ₹ 0.30 lakh.

This has reference to the above-mentioned para-2 regarding Overstatement of depreciation on Fixed Assets (Schedule-4) of Rs. 29737.

The depreciation has been charged as per approved rates and Accounting Policy of the University. Due to calculation errors, the depreciation calculated for whole year instead of half year which has been corrected and reflected in the books of Accounts of Current Financial Year 2022-23.


Since, depreciation is finally reduced from the cost of Assets and Corpus fund; as such there is no loss on this account. Audit observation accepted and rectified. Audit is requested to exclude this para.

Draft Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the accounts of Central University of Rajasthan, Bandar Sindri, Kishangarh (Ajmer) for the year ended 31 March 2022

1. Introduction

Central University of Rajasthan (CURAJ), Bandar Sindri, Kishangarh (Ajmer) was established in March 2009 by an Act of Parliament (The Central Universities Act, 2009). The CURAJ is established for teaching and research in the State and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. The Mission of the CURAJ is to contribute to and work with a sense of commitment towards the educational, cultural, economic, environmental, health and social advancement of the region and the nation at large by providing excellent undergraduate liberal education and quality programs leading to bachelors, masters, professional and doctorate degrees.

Section 31(1) of the Act provides that the Annual Accounts of the CURAJ shall be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India. The audit of Annual Accounts of the CURAJ was conducted under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971.

2. Grant-in-aid

The CURAJ has received grant-in-aid of ₹ 51.67 crore (including refund of ₹ 2.60 crore by Public Health Engineering Department) during the year 2021-22. Unspent grant of ₹ 13.10 crore was available at the beginning of the year. Out of total available grant of ₹ 60.01 crore (excluding refund/pull back of ₹ 4.76 crore by University Grants Commission), CURAJ could utilise ₹ 49.50 crore (Capital expenditure: ₹ 3.64 crore and Revenue expenditure: ₹ 45.86 crore) leaving a balance of ₹ 10.51 crore at the end of the year.

3. Comments on Accounts

Balance Sheet of the University

A. Application of Funds

Fixed Assets-Capital WIP-HEFA Loan Scheme (Schedule-4B): ₹ 1639.80 lakh

As per formats of financial statements for Central Higher Educational Institutions prescribed by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) advances to suppliers/contractors for capital works should be shown in Schedule-8 (Loans, Advances and Deposits).

A.1 During scrutiny of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 it was noticed that term loans amounting to ₹ 56.03 crore (₹ 5.47 crore + ₹ 36.90 crore + ₹ 13.66 crore) were sanctioned by Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA) for construction of three buildings in the premises of CURAJ. Out of this, ₹ 16.40 crore had been released to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) upto 31.3.2022. As per physical and financial progress report submitted by CPWD ₹ 13.51 crore were utilised upto 31.03.2022. CURAJ has shown the amount released to CPWD in Schedule-4B Fixed Assets (HEFA Loan Scheme) as Capital Work-in-Progress (₹ 13.51 crore) and Capital Advance (₹ 2.89 crore) whereas ₹ 13.51 crore only were to be shown under Schedule-4 Fixed Assets (Capital Work-in-Progress) and ₹ 2.89 crore were to be shown under Schedule-8 Loans, Advances & Deposits.

This has resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 2.89 crore and understatement of Loans, Advances & Deposits by the same amount.

Balance Sheet of School of Education

Fixed Assets (Schedule-4): ₹ 108.31 lakh

A.2 During scrutiny of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 it was noticed that ₹ 171.02 lakh were sanctioned for construction of school building by the MHRD. Out of this, ₹ 108.31 lakh had been released to CPWD upto 31.3.2022. As per physical and financial progress report submitted by CPWD ₹ 92.15 lakh were utilised upto 31.03.2022. CURAJ has shown the amount released to CPWD in Schedule-4 Fixed Assets as Capital Work-in-Progress (₹ 92.15 lakh) and Capital Advance (₹ 16.16 lakh) whereas ₹ 92.15 lakh only were to be shown under Schedule-4 Fixed Assets (Capital Work-in-Progress) and ₹ 16.16 lakh were to be shown under Schedule-8: Loans, Advances & Deposits.

This has resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 16.16 lakh and understatement of Loans, Advances & Deposits by the same amount.

Balance Sheet of Department of Yoga

Fixed Assets (Schedule-4): ₹ 232.72 lakh

A.3 During scrutiny of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 it was noticed that ₹ 399.04 lakh were sanctioned for construction of building of Yoga Department by the MHRD. Out of this, ₹ 232.72 lakh had been released to CPWD upto 31.3.2022. As per physical and financial progress report submitted by CPWD ₹ 215.01 lakh were utilised upto 31.03.2022. CURAJ has shown the amount released to CPWD in Schedule-4 Fixed Assets as Capital Work-in-Progress (₹ 215.01 lakh) and Capital Advance (₹ 17.71 lakh) whereas ₹ 215.01 lakh only were to be shown under Schedule-4 Fixed Assets (Capital Work-in-Progress) and ₹ 17.71 lakh were to be shown under Schedule-8 Loans, Advances & Deposits.

This has resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 17.71 lakh and understatement of Loans, Advances & Deposits by the same amount.

On being pointed out the above observations vide audit enquiry nos.118443, 119202 and 119224 dated 13.07.2022, 14.07.2022 and 14.07.2022 respectively, CURAJ replied that according to Accounting Policy (Schedule 23 item No. 3.5), the presentation of this advance shown under capital WIP in the annual accounts of the University. Reply is not acceptable as guidelines and instructions issued by MHRD to prepare annual accounts provide that advance payments to contractors and suppliers should not be classified under the specific fixed assets or as capital work in progress and should be shown under Loans, Advances & Deposits.

B. General

B.1 As per the instructions issued for Schedule-4 in Formats of Financial Statements for Central Higher Educational Institutions issued by MHRD "Fixed Assets in the course of construction should be shown against this head till they are ready for their intended use." Buildings/premises shall be those which are intended to be wholly/partly used for the purposes of the activities of the Entity and would not include "Investment Properties". Further, para 3.6 of Schedule-23: Significant Accounting

Policies provides that depreciation on Buildings is provided on Written Down Value (WDV) method at the rate of 5 per cent.

It was noticed that CURAJ had incurred expenditure on construction of various works/buildings. The same had been completed by the CPWD. However, CURAJ had neither capitalised nor depreciation was charged thereon.

This comment was also raised in Separate Audit Reports for the years 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 but the irregularity persists.

B.2 Significant Accounting Policies (Schedule:23, Para 4.2) of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 provides that Software, E-Books and Library Support (In resources) Perpetual Access are shown separately under Intangible Assets.

Scrutiny of Annual Accounts of CURAJ for the year 2021-22 revealed that E-Books valuing ₹ 40.94 lakh purchased during the year 2021-22 was included in head Library Books and Scientific Journals instead of showing the same under the head E-Books & Journals. Thus, E-Books were misclassified as Library Books and Scientific Journals under Fixed Assets.

On being pointed out vide audit enquiry no. 115710 dated 08.07.2022, it was replied that due to oversight, that amount was included in Library Books & Scientific Journals, while presenting in annual accounts. Proper head of accounts will be corrected during the FY 2022-23 to reflect proper classification of Fixed Assets.

B.3 Significant Accounting Policies (Schedule 23, Para 3.7-i) of Annual Accounts of-CURAJ for the year 2021-22 provides that the depreciation is charged for the full year if the assets are acquired upto 30 September, otherwise 50 per cent of the prescribed rate is applicable. It also provides (Para 3.7-ii) that depreciation on the individual assets costing less than or equal to ₹ 5000 (except Library Books) is charged at the rate of 100 per cent.

It was noticed that depreciation on three assets has been overcharged by ₹ 2.05 lakh and that on one asset has been undercharged by ₹ 1.75 lakh. Thus, depreciation has been overcharged by ₹ 0.30 lakh. Details are as under:

This has resulted in understatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 0.30 lakh and understatement of Corpus/Capital fund by the same amount.

On being pointed out vide audit enquiry no. 115667 dated 08.07.2022, it was replied that the depreciation has been charged as per approved rates of the University and Accounting Policy. Due to calculation errors, depreciation was charged for the whole year instead of half year which has now been corrected and the same has been reflected to the books of Accounts during the FY 2022-23.

C. Net impact of audit comments on Accounts

The net impact of comments given in the preceding paragraphs is that as on 31 March 2022 assets were understated by ₹ 0.30 lakh and liabilities were understated by ₹ 0.30 lakh.

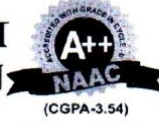

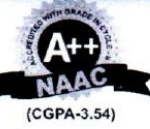
