

## **Nearby Tourist Places**



#### AMER (AMBER) FORT, JAIPUR

The Amber Fort was built by 'Raja Shri Maan Singh JI Saheb' (Maan Singh I) (December 21, 1550 – July 6, 1614) in 16th century. Man Singh began the construction of a fortress-palace of white and red sandstone i.e. Amber Fort in 1592.



#### KISHANGARH FORT, KISHANGARH

The Kishangarh Fort in Ajmer is an imposing structure that was built in the year 1653. Maharaja Roop Singh built the massive Kishangarh Fort. The interiors of the Kishangarh fort are beautifully decorated with extensive murals and paintings.



#### **AJMER SHARIF DARGAH, AJMER**

Ajmer Sharif Dargah is a Sufi Tomb (dargah) of the Sufi saint, Khawaja Moinuddin Chishti, located at Ajmer Shareef, Rajasthan. The white marble dome of Chishti's shrine was built in 1532. The dargah has a royal darbar, Mehfil Khana that was constructed in 1888.



#### HAWA MAHAL, JAIPUR

Hawa Mahal is a sample of the perfection of the architecture. The Hawa Mahal, part of the Jaipur city palace complex is a familiar landmark, and is ties of pierced windows overlooking the street below.



#### **NARELI JAIN TEMPLE, AJMER**

The temple is situated on the Aravali mountain range. The temple is an important Jain pilgrimage site for Digambar Jains. The temple complex consists 24 small Jinalaya for 24 tirthankars.



#### **BRAHMA TEMPLE PUSHKAR, AJMER**

Brahma Temple, Pushkar is a Hindu temple situated at Pushkar, Ajmer. The temple is made of marble and stone slabs. The present structure of the temple goes back to the 14th century, while the original structure is believed to be around 2000 years back.
