



## General Admission Policy for Academic Year 2026-27

### For Admission in

#### **Four-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme ITEP– B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage with Major in Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics)**

**Important Instruction:** Candidates are advised to ensure their eligibility before applying. Detailed eligibility criteria for **ITEP– B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage with Major in Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics)** are displayed on the Central University of Rajasthan official website.

1. Candidates, who have successfully cleared the Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) and seek admission in **Four-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme, ITEP– B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary Stage with Major in Physics/Chemistry/Mathematics)**, can register at the CURAJ admission portal for counselling. Candidates are required to pay a non-refundable registration fee Rs. 400/- for General Category and Rs. 250/- for all reserved category (EWS/OBC-NCL/SC/ST/PWD) (plus transaction charges and taxes as applicable) to complete the online registration.
2. After the last date of registration, a comprehensive merit list based on NCET scores will be published on the University website.
3. Keeping in view the participation of a large number of Universities in NCET conducted by NTA, prospective candidates may have numerous choices. In order to ensure the timely completion of the admission process and commencement of the academic session well-in-time, the University will invite proportionately more candidates than available seats for depositing academic fee.
4. The Departmental Admission Committee (DAC) will check the eligibility of all the candidates who have paid the registration fee. The Department may contact the candidate for any clarification related to his/her candidature and may also ask for the re/submission of the required/missing/ unclear document(s).
5. All the eligible candidates will be invited to deposit the academic fee.
6. The information related to depositing the academic fee will be displayed on the University Website.
7. The candidate must pay the academic fee within the stipulated time, failing which his/her candidature shall immediately be cancelled. Besides, it is to note that the payment of academic fee does not guarantee admission. The list of candidates, who have deposited academic fee, will be displayed on the University website.
8. If the candidate is found ineligible at any stage, his/her candidature will stand cancelled in that programme.
9. From the list of eligible candidates who have deposited academic fees, seats will be offered in order to NCET merit. The merit list will be prepared as per the reservation policy of Government of India. Further, it will be displayed on the University's website.



10. The waiting list of the candidates, who have deposited fees but have not been offered admission by then, will also be displayed on the University website. Candidates who have deposited the academic fee but are not offered admission will be refunded their deposited fee as per the University's refund policy.
11. Any candidates not complying with the procedure mentioned above (e.g. not paying the Academic Fee and/or not uploading the documents/undertaking/affidavit, etc.) within the stipulated time frame will result in the cancellation of the admission offer and deletion of the name from the merit list. In such a case, the seat shall be declared vacant and will be offered to the next eligible candidate(s) in the order of merit.
12. Vacancies resulting from cancellation/withdrawal will be filled from the waiting list.
13. The procedure of admission cancellation/refund policy will be updated on the University website.
14. If there is a tie in the NCET Score considered for merit, the University Tie-breaking Policy (ANNEXURE - I) will be followed.

### ANNEXURE - I Tie - Breaking Policy

**In case of a tie in the NCET score, the following procedure shall be followed, in order to determine merit:**

1. The candidate, who scored higher marks in the qualifying degree, will be first offered the seat.
2. If there is a further tie in the score with regard to the above-mentioned Point-1(the case of same score in the qualifying degree), the seat will be offered to the candidate, who has scored higher marks in the Teaching Aptitude in NCET score will be given preference.
3. If there is a further tie in the score with regard to the above-mentioned Point-1&2, the seat will be offered to the candidate, who has scored higher marks in the General knowledge in NCET score will be given preference.
4. If the tie still continues, the candidate who is older in age will be given preference.
5. In case, the tie continues further with regard to all of the above-mentioned cases(Point 1, 2, 3 & 4), the decision of the competent authority will be final and binding.
