INTRA UNIVERSITY SPORTS MEET

WHAT ARE INTRAUNIVERSITY SPORTS?

The Interuniversity sports program at the CURAJ is one component of the department of sports and Campus Recreation within the Division of Student Services. The Program is very structured and offers individual, dual, and team sports for male and female participation. Participation was required, and an individual does not have to be highly skilled to participate.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Interuniversity Sports Meet was to provide an opportunity for every student at the CURAJ to participate in some type of competitive sports activity as regularly as his/her interest, ability, and time will permit. The rules and regulations which have been formulated for the activities in this program take into consideration the necessary preparation for each activity as well as the degree of skill of each participant.

Sports have been an integral part of curaj for years. Keeping up the tradition, this year too, curaj organized its intra university Sports Meet with the same flamboyant spirit, on the 24th-27th of march. Intramural activities range from traditional sports such as athletics, basketball, football, volleyball to non-traditional sports such as badminton, and cross country.

The event commenced with The Torch Relay began from academic block (SP 4) and culminated at football field. 7km journey across the CURAJ campus. 
All club presidents conducted trials for their respective event with the help of student co-ordinators up to 22nd march 2017 and submitted team list with captain name to the sports office.

OFFICIAL DRAW SHEET-SINGLE ELIMINATION (knock out)
6 team single elimination

In a single-elimination tournament, teams continue to play as long as they win. It is essential that the elimination tournament chart be drawn to include space in the first round matches for a number of teams, which is a power of two. For example: 4, 8, 16, 32, etc. If the number of teams entering the tournament is not a power of two, the next higher power of two must be determined and bracket space provided for this next higher power of two. Byes are then used to fill in the empty lines.

For example:

If 06 teams are entered in the tournament, extra spaces must be added in the first round because 06 is not a power of two. Therefore, the first round of the tournament must provide for 8 teams. Two of the 6 teams must have a Bye in the 1st round. The formula for determining the necessary number of Byes is: The number of teams entered subtracted from the next higher power of two. 06 teams subtracted from 8 equal **2Byes**. 1st bye to last team of lower half and 2nd bye to top team of first half.



GENERAL GUIDELINES

PLAYER CONDUCT

1. Any player who uses false/ non decorative language or who flagrantly disobeys the rules of the contest, or who flagrantly disagrees...by action or words...with an official decision, shall be expelled from the game. Players will also be ineligible to play in the next game those there team plays.
2. Any player who repeatedly or wilfully commits flagrant violations, or who instigates or joins in a fight shall be expelled from that contest and will not be allowed to participate in any further Intra-university or Sports club activities for the remainder of next school year.

TEAM CONDUCT

1. It will be the duty of each team captain to control the actions of all team members representing that team. Any harassment of officials or members of the opposing team, by either player or coach, shall result in the forfeit of that contest. Repeated Violations of this rule will cause the suspension of that team for the remainder of the Intra-University season.

Note: - Students were allowed to participate only in two Games. In athletics one student can participate in two events except relay race.
