Free Coaching for Civil Services Exam (2025-26)**

All willing/eligible beneficiaries under Vacant seats of SC Candidates and “PM CARES for Children Scheme” are invited to take admission under SPOT round at Dr Ambedkar Centre of Excellence, Central University of Rajasthan for the year of 2025-26.

Benefits

1. Stipend
 - ₹4,000 per month (up to a maximum of 12 months)
2. Interview Incentive
 - ₹15,000 for students who clear the mains stage of Central/State Civil Services (Class I & II)
3. Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)
 - All financial benefits (stipend & fees) are transferred directly to the student's Aadhaar-linked bank account
4. Course Fee Coverage

Eligibility for PM CARES Children Scheme

- All beneficiaries of the PM CARES Children Scheme who have a certificate (with beneficiary ID) issued by the Central Government confirming their status as beneficiaries are eligible.
- There will be no income or caste-related restrictions for such beneficiaries to avail of the benefits under this scheme.

Vacant Seats:

- **21 Seats (Including 05 seats reserved for female SC candidates)**
- **PM CARES For Children Scheme - All beneficiaries considered for admission**

Note: Merit list will be prepared on the basis of receiving of application during SPOT round, and offered admission.

- **Graduation Percentage will be considered for preparation of merit.**
- **If, any tie-up in the graduation percentage, 12th percentage will be considered.**

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Documents Required: 02 sets of all applicable documents

1. Recent Passport Size Photograph (02)
2. PM Cares Children Scheme Letter (Not applicable for SC Candidates)
3. Aadhaar card.
4. Residence Proof.
5. Age Proof.
6. Mark-sheet of Class 12th, (Minimum 50%)
7. Graduation
8. Bank Passbook / Canceled cheque (Aadhar seeded proof)
9. PWD certificate (if applicable)
10. Declaration that he/she has not taken benefit more than twice under the Scheme or any other similar coaching scheme run by the Central or State Government.
11. Declaration that he/she is not availing benefits under any other coaching scheme of the Centre or State Government.
12. Minimum age for admission will be 21 years at the time of admission.
13. If, any candidate found pursuing any full time/regular study in any program at any institution, admission will be canceled immediately.
14. If any disciplinary actions taken by any government department / institutions, will not considered for admission.
15. If any dispute, final decision will be considered by competent authority.

Additional eligibility for SC Candidates:

- Income certificate: Income declaration of self-employed parents/guardian should be in the form of a certificate issued by a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. Employed parents/ guardians are required to obtain income certificate from their employer and submit consolidated certificate from Revenue Officer including any other additional source of income.
- Students belonging to SCs, having total family income of Rs. 8.00 lakh or less per annum from all sources will be eligible for benefits under the Scheme.
