**Advertisement for the post of JRF / Project Associate-I (1 post)**

Applications are invited for the post of **Junior Research Fellow (JRF) / Project Associate-I** on a purely contractual basis to work on the SERB sponsored CRG project (Grant No.: **CRG/2022/008471**), titled "*Investigation of Diverse Reactivity Patterns in Morita-Baylis-Hillman Ketones to access Biologically Significant Heterocyclic Scaffolds*", sanctioned to Dr. Easwar Srinivasan, Associate Professor at the Department of Chemistry, Central University of Rajasthan.

<b>Position</b>	Junior Research Fellow / Project Associate-I (1 post; <i>contract basis</i> )
<b>Tenure of the position</b>	One Year from the date of appointment (with a possibility of extension based on the candidate's performance and the availability of funds)
<b>Essential Qualification</b>	M.Sc. Chemistry/Organic/Organometallic Chemistry (minimum 55% or equivalent CGPA). Preference will be given to the candidates that have qualified CSIR-UGC NET including lectureship (LS) and/or GATE or equivalent examination.
<b>Desirable</b>	<i>Working experience in the area of synthetic organic chemistry, with hands-on experience of purification and characterization techniques.</i>
<b>Consolidated salary (per month)</b>	Rs.31,000/- (For NET/GATE qualified); Rs. 25,000/- (For non-NET/GATE candidates)
